



MICROCHIP IMPLANTATION CERTIFICATE

Microchips will be issued for each foal registered with the OHBS-GOV. The numbers that are recorded in the microchip will also be placed in your foal's passport and the German database. Throughout your horse's life these microchips will provide vital identification information through scanning. We therefore require that you have your veterinarian insert the microchip in your foal as soon as possible after inspection. Your foal's passport will not be issued until we receive back this signed and completed microchip implantation certificate.

The microchip, which is the size of a grain of rice, should be inserted into the left side of the neck, about halfway between the poll and the withers, and about two inches below the crest of the neck. The chip should be inserted into the top layer of muscle at an angle of approximately 15 degrees. The chip is not to be inserted as a sub-cutaneous injection. We recommend that you have this procedure performed by a qualified veterinarian. Because of the fractiousness of some young horses and size of the needle through which the microchip is inserted, some people may choose to block the area with local anesthetic.
